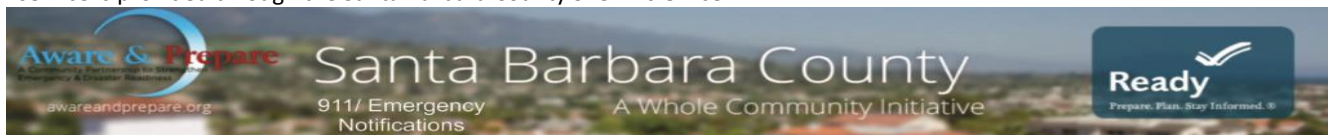

Overview

- The focus is on the General Fund.
- 17-18 Budget approved by Council shows General Fund revenues exceeding expenditures by 37,000.
- At March 31, 2018 we are 75% through the year. The General Fund revenues are on track with budget. We have received 74.4% of revenues.
- General Fund Expenditures are under budget at 68.7% expended as of March 31, 2018.
