POSITION SUMMARY: This is a regular, full-time position, eligible for benefits. Upon hire, there will be a thorough training program as mandated by P.O.S.T. Under general supervision, on a regular or assigned shift, this position will perform a variety of patrol and related duties, to include patrolling the City; enforcing Federal, State and local laws and ordinances; providing information and assistance to the public, and other related duties as assigned. **Additional Duties:** Complete EMS training at the entry-level job duties and responsibilities required by an EMS worker within fire and ambulance services, and various non-traditional EMS roles such as providing medical coverage for large scale public events.

QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS:

- High School Diploma, or equivalent (GED)
- Basic Certificate issued by the California State Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.), ability to requalify for P.O.S.T. Basic Certificate or graduation from an accredited police academy
- Valid California Driver's License, Class "C", with a clean, satisfactory driving record

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Successful completion of a background investigation, polygraph, psychological examination, and pre-employment medical examination which includes physical agility and alcohol/agility.
