CARRY CONCEALED WEAPON (CCW) POLICY STATEMENT SUMMARY OF PENAL CODE §26150

California Penal Code §26150 provides that the Chief of Police may issue a concealed weapon license to law abiding residents of the City of Guadalupe, California provided that proof of all of the following criteria is met:

- (1) The applicant is of good moral character.
- (2) The applicant is a resident of the City of Guadalupe and provides proof of residence.
- (3) The applicant has completed a course of training as described in Section 26165.

The concealed weapons license allows the licensee to carry a pistol revolver, or other firearm capable of being concealed upon the person.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Complete DOJ Standard Application

Applications for a concealed weapons license (CCW) will need to schedule an in-office appointment to submit supporting documentation. You may pay with in person with a credit card, Cash, or check.

Each application will be reviewed by staff to determine initial eligibility. Applications accepted will be individually investigated to determine residency and moral character, and anyone on any form of probation is automatically disqualified. The Department of Justice and the Guadalupe Police Department are both involved in the processing of this application, each agency requires certain fees.

The current fee schedule is as follows:

- Standard (Two-year) Permit: \$137 (Includes \$93 DOJ live Scan Fee, \$25 PD Live Scan Rolling Fee)
- Issuance Fee: \$80 (Only if permit is approved)

Additional Fees:

- Renewal Fee - \$77 (includes \$52 DOJ Fee and \$25 PD Fee)

Fees are subject to change as allowed by law. They are processing fees and, as such, are not refundable regardless of the decision made on the application.

Complete the Approved CCW Firearms Instruction Course

- Applicant pays cost

Complete a Background Investigation

- Applicant pays cost

Successfully Complete the Approved Psychologist Testing

- Applicant pays cost, up to \$150.00

Documentation

All new applicants must demonstrate they are residents of the City of Guadalupe and good moral character, pursuant to Penal Code §26150. For purposes of this application, applicants must submit proof of residency in the form of two current monthly bills that list their name, service address and mailing address (or other similar type proof). It is preferred that at least one of the monthly bills be a utility bill.

After your application is reviewed, additional documentation may be requested. Valid California identification is also required. If you are currently in the military, a copy of your orders must be uploaded along with your current State identification or driver's license.

(ALL steps MUST be successfully completed and passed before issuance of the permit)
